The McHenry County Youth Sports Association (MCYSA) is pleased to announce that Gregg Sibigroth has been named the Executive Tournament Director of MCYSA.

MCYSA is the not-for-profit organization that has hosted and run the 15-Year Old CABA World Series Tournament in Crystal Lake, Woodstock and surrounding McHenry County communities for the past 15 years. In 2006 MCYSA also began hosting the 9 and 11-Year Old World Series events.

Gregg brings a wealth of baseball and business experience to the position of Executive Director. He is currently the owner of Players Choice Academy in Huntley and formally owned and operated Grand Slam Academy in LITH. Gregg is in the process of opening a second Players Choice Academy location in the former Grand Slam site in LITH. He has served as the 11-Year Old Tournament Director for the past 2 years and has served in various capacities for the event over the 12 years ranging from the Opening Banquet, to the Skills Competitions to Assistant Tournament Director.

Gregg brings an intimate knowledge of the workings of the World Series to the position as well as the respect of the local Tournament Committee, the Chicago area baseball community and the national baseball community. Gregg's experience, enthusiasm, attention to detail and commitment to taking the event to new heights assures the continued success of the annual event which generates in excess of \$2,000,000.00 of sales each year locally and brings teams from as far away as Japan, Puerto Rico and from coast to coast in the United States.
